Highlights of 2022

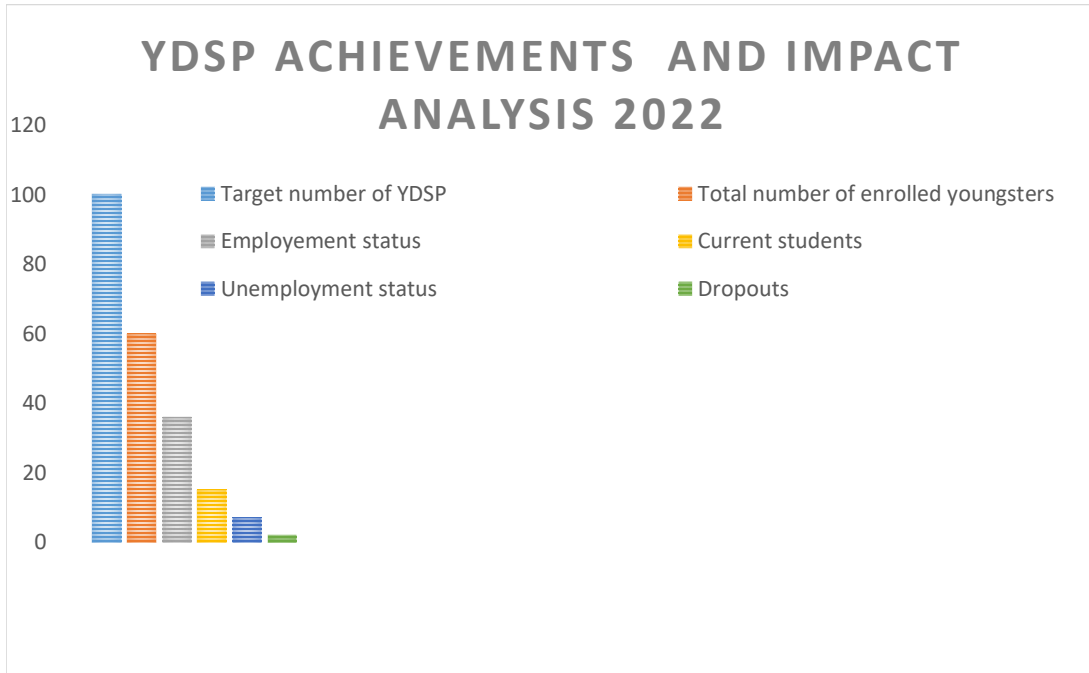
60 youngsters have been sponsored to obtain their Vocational Certificate in Culinary Arts
