100 Youngsters trained in the job-readiness professional skills workshops of CC-JOBS

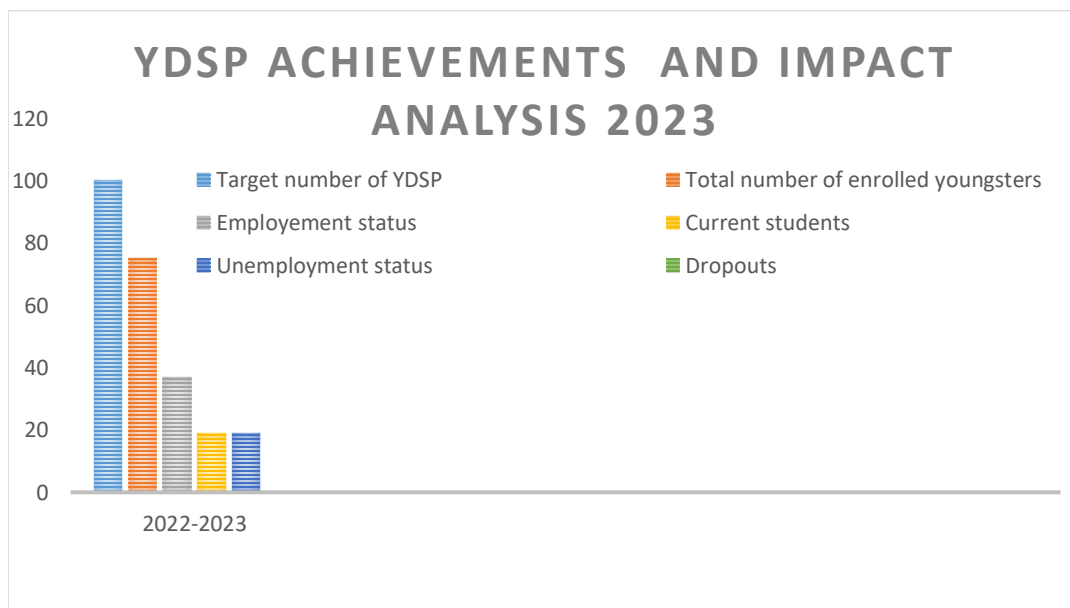
66 % employment rate of our graduates in 2023

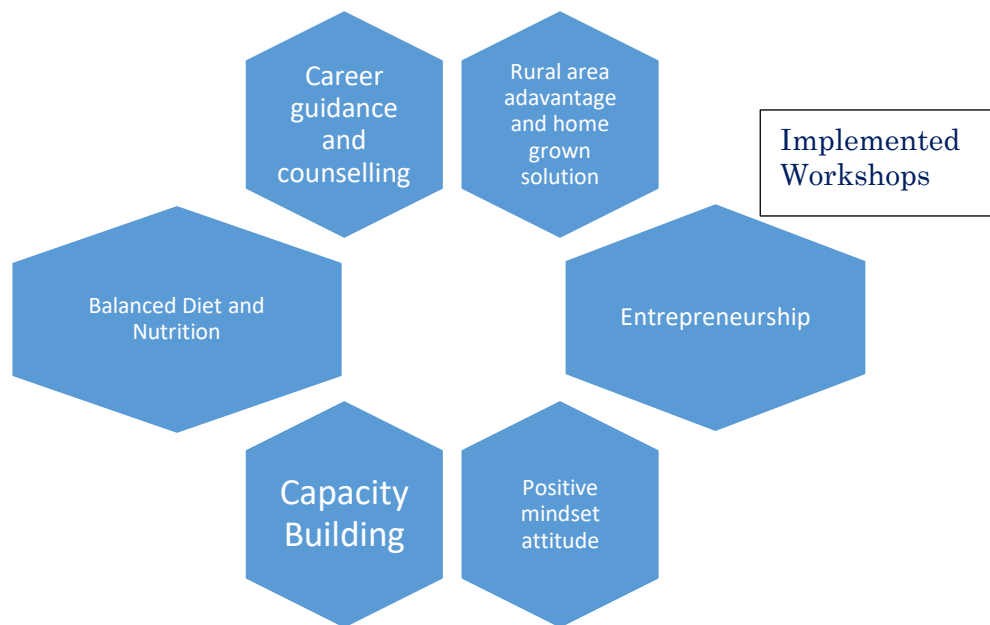


Our Fifth group of students during their Culinary Arts Vocational Training Program in 2023

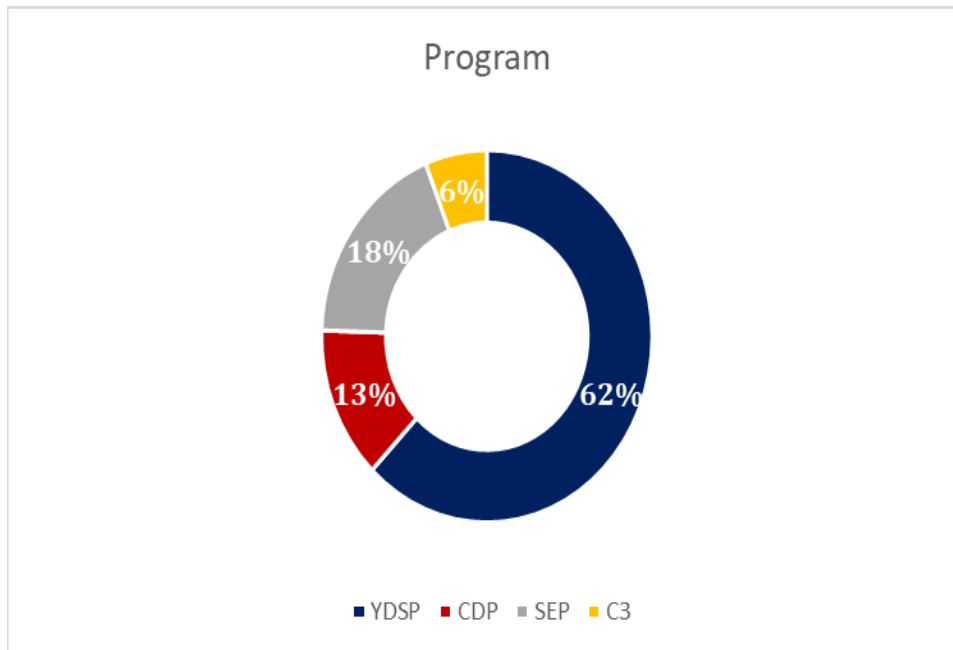

Abdul Hakim was one of the top culinary arts students in the class of 2021. He received his Vocational certificate with a high grade as a cook after completing our program. He did not return home and wait for a career chance, but instead used the entrepreneurship skills he gained from our program. In order to live, he started a neighborhood BBQ.

He obtained a job as a cook in Oman three months later. Now that he has changed his life and is married, he is taking care of his family with the money he earns from his new work.



She was born and raised in Kigali's largest slum area, Gitega Sector. She completed her internship at Hôtel des Mille Collines, one of our partner hotels and one of the greatest hotels in Kigali, where she was later hired and is currently working as an assistant chef.

She is now truly prepared to change her life, that of her family, and that of her community. UWASE UWIKEZA Belyse is her name; one of our beloved graduates.
